

Ring Toss

REQUIRED MATERIALS

6 paper plates, 1 paper towel roll, tape, scissors, colors or markers or stickers,

Supplies in the bag:

- 1 Paper towel roll
- 6 Paper plates

What you need from home:

- Crayons or markers
- Clear tape
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

The Goal

1. Find the 1st paper plate with a small hole marked in the middle
2. Fold the plate in half along the dotted line
3. Cut out the hole with scissors
4. Decorate the paper towel roll using crayons or markers

Options: You can paint the roll in advance to let it dry before putting the goal together.

5. Flip the paper plate with the hole upside down and decorate
6. Cut small slits in bottom of paper towel roll, approximately 1" apart
7. Lightly fan out slits and tape down in the circle of 2nd paper plate
8. Slide the first paper plate with small hole down paper towel roll, decorated side up, to complete ring toss goal base

Rings

1. Cut large holes in the other 4 paper plates using the method above
2. Decorate each ring

Play

Toss paper plate rings toward goal, trying to land the rings around the paper towel roll.

CRYSAL CRAFTS

REQUIRED SUPPLIES

- Pipe cleaners
- String
- Pencil or wooden skewer
- Borax
- Warm water
- Liquid measuring cup
- Tablespoon
- Heat safe mixing bowl/container
- Plastic container larger enough to hold molded pipe cleaner
 - Name, initials, heart, cross, etc...

Supplies in the bag:

1. Styrofoam cup (will need bigger if using more than one cup of water)
2. Piece of string
3. 3 pieces of pipe cleaners

Supplies required from home:

- Plastic container larger enough to hold molded pipe cleaner
- Pencil or wooden skewer
- Warm water
- Liquid measuring cup
- Tablespoon
- Heat safe mixing bowl/container

Step One:

Decide if you want to form your entire name in cursive, just your first and last initials, or a shape. This will determine the size of plastic or glass container or cup in which you will use to dip the finished pipe cleaners into.

Step Two – **FOR PARENTS OR SUPERVISOR**

3 TBSP of Borax per 1 Cup of water

While your child is forming his/her pipe cleaners, you will need to heat enough water to cover the shape.

Example: If they want to shape a heart (and it will fit in the Styrofoam cup), heat 1 cup of water then mix the 3 TBSPs Borax until it is dissolved.

Just remember that there are only 6 TBSP premeasured Borax in the baggie. Explain that the shape needs to fit into specified container.

Step Three:

Tie the string onto one end of the shape once the pipe cleaner is finished. Dip it into the container and tie the other end of the string to the pencil or skewer. That will sit on the edges of the container and dangle or float the shape in the Borax mix. Place the mixture on a shelf where it will not be disturbed.

Step Four:

WAITING !!!!!

Let it sit overnight. When you pull out their shape it should dazzle everyone. You can decide if you want to hang it in a window.

This technique can be used later for Christmas ornaments or Halloween decorations.
